PA-771 AIR FORCE JROTC CADET CONTRACT

- 1. UNDERSTANDING: Belonging to the cadet corps is a privilege and not a right. The staff reserves the right to remove anyone from the program if they are not meeting the minimum standards spelled out in this contract and the PA-771 Cadet Guide. All cadets must be in the program voluntarily.
- 2. OBLIGATIONS AND CONSIDERATIONS: Participation in AFJROTC does not commit or obligate any student to military service. It does not guarantee special consideration if a student chooses to enter any service. However, a cadet who completes two to three years of AFJROTC may qualify for advanced rank upon enlistment in the military. Additionally, students who complete two years of AFJROTC and are enrolled in their senior year are typically more competitive for AFJROTC scholarships.
- **3. APPLICATION:** I, the above named cadet, hereby apply for enrollment in the PA-771 Air Force JROTC Program (Coatesville Area Senior High School).
- 4. AGREEMENT: (Aerospace Science Instructors) Upon acceptance of this application and the fulfillment of the conditions on the part of the cadet, the Senior Aerospace Science instructor (SASI) and the Aerospace Science Instructor (ASI) agree to: (1) Help develop citizens of character, dedicated to serving others. (2) Instill responsibility, character, accountability and self-discipline. (3) Provide instruction in air and space fundamentals, leadership education, and military drill. (4) Encourage physical fitness. (5) Familiarize the students with the U.S. Air Force and the scholarship and career opportunities that it offers to qualified graduates. (6) Run a fully compliant AFJROTC program mandated by the U.S. Air Force.
- **5. AGREEMENT**: **(Cadet)** In order to maintain the high standards of courtesy, personal conduct, and appearance required by the Air Force and PA-771 as a cadet, I understand and agree to:
 - A. Meet the standards of behavior, attitude, and courtesy established and taught by the Instructors. I understand and agree that indifference to training or discipline problems such as disrespect toward instructors or higher ranking cadets, dishonesty, failure to follow directions of those in authority, using a cell phone without permission, initiating a fight, or suspension from school for misbehavior may result in removal from the program and non-selection for future enrollment in AFJROTC.
 - B. I will wear the regulation Air Force uniform on those occasions and for the duration prescribed by the SASI and outlined in the course syllabus. Refusal to wear the uniform as required or improper use of the uniform will result in my removal from AFJROTC. Removal from the program will result in a failing grade for the course. Uniform Day is normally every Wednesday, or Thursday as a makeup day. A missed uniform inspection must be made up or I will fail the marking period.
 - C. I will maintain the uniform in a clean, properly fitted, and repaired manner. I will turn in the complete uniform upon demand. I am responsible for the cost of cleaning and loss, theft, or damage of uniform items. At the end of the school year all uniforms must be returned dry-cleaned and in cellophane bags with receipts attached unless a \$30 fee was prepaid by the cadet.

- D. I will meet and maintain the personal grooming standards established by the Air Force. I will pay particular attention to military haircut standards (including authorized style, length and color), facial hair, body piercing, tattoos, makeup, and body jewelry, as described in the PA-771 Cadet Guide and AFI 36-2903.
- E. I must maintain an acceptable standard of academic performance in all classes. I will complete all assignments given to me by my instructors. I will be active in classroom work and strive to participate in co-curricular activities of AFJROTC. (Cadets should participate in as many cocurricular activities as possible. Service Award credit is earned in this way.) I must earn a final grade of a "B" or better in AFJROTC and a "C" or better overall Grade Point Average to be eligible for AFJROTC the next year without a waiver from the SASI. I understand that a final grade of "F" in AFJROTC will result in my not being allowed to re-enroll in AFJROTC.
- F. I will participate in the Wellness/Physical Training (PT) portion of the AFJROTC curriculum. I understand that one day a week will be dedicated to Wellness/PT and I will be graded on participation and if I wear the issued PA-771 PT uniform (NOTE: proper shoes are required to participate and be in uniform).
- G. I will respond positively to other cadets who have been appointed to leadership positions in the Cadet Group. Rendering proper military courtesies to instructors and other cadets with senior rank is a necessity. I will express courtesy and respect to administrators, teachers, coaches, and other adults. I will conduct myself properly when I am entrusted with a position of leadership.
- H. I will meet the objectives of the Cadet Corps which are to: (1) Encourage a high degree of personal honor, self-reliance, and leadership, (2) Promote patriotism, (3) Develop habits of orderliness and precision, (4) Develop a respect for constituted authority, and (5) Develop the ability to perform basic skills associated with drill.
- I. I will strive to develop self-discipline and accept personal responsibility for my actions.
- J. I will take proper care of textbook materials provided by the Air Force and return them when requested to do so. I will make payment to the AFJROTC office for any books damaged or lost.
