

## **Early Childhood Educators Program with Shippensburg University**

The program offers college courses (**completely online**) where students can earn their Child Development Associate (CDA) credential and 9 credits towards their future college endeavors. There is NO COST for students and families, this program is fully funded through a PA State Grant. - The program is for juniors and seniors
- 3 education courses – 1 course per semester (if students are not starting the program until senior year, students will need to take 2 courses during a semester to complete all 3 by the end of high school)

  - *Positive Behavioral Support for Young Children*
  - *Becoming an Early Childhood Professional*
- Online and asynchronous learning – 1 zoom meeting a month
