#### **Chester County**


- The Delaware County Council is offering 1 Cohort for this 38-credit Pathway over two years (2025-2027)
- Courses will be held at DCCC's Pennocks
   Bridge location, taught by DCCC Faculty.
- Courses will begin August 25, 2025.
- Courses will mostly be offered in-person, some may include hybrid online with asynchronous formats.



#### What Does This Include?

Free Courses!	All courses and required textbooks will be covered by the Delaware County Council
Experience!	Field Experience hours will be offered at various elementary schools in Chester County
Transferability!	Courses can be transferrable to West Chester University and others!
Head Start!	Gain college experience while still in high school, getting a head start on your degree!






### What's Required?

#### **Chester County**

- Must currently be a sophomore (a junior beginning Fall 2024)
  - Application Deadline March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025
- Must have college level scores
  - Placement Test Deadline April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025
  - Submit qualifying PSAT/SAT/ACT or Keystone scores (dccc.edu/assessment) <u>OR</u> complete the Accuplacer Placement Test.



### Eligibility & More

#### **Chester County**

- Eligibility to participate in this program is determined by application completion date and time as well as course placement
- DCCC policies will govern student registration, withdrawals and grading.
- Students will receive a letter grade for each course at the end of each semester.

<sup>\*</sup>Course placement will determine if a high school dual enrollment student is eligible to register for selected college courses. Some students are eligible to waive the placement test with qualifying standardized test scores.

- Once the application is submitted, students must send an email to our Admissions Office (admiss@dccc.edu) to confirm that they applied.
- Students will then receive instructions to schedule the Placement Test or send Qualifying Test Scores.
