It is with great excitement that I let you know of the many partnerships between Oxford Area School District and four-year colleges. OASD is recognized for the innovative opportunities we offer our students to start college while in high school. Over the past four years we have hosted an "Early College Academy" with Cecil College. This past January, OASD entered into an agreement with Thaddeus Stevens Technical College for an "Early Admissions Program". Starting the fall 2018 OASD will launch a new Early College Academy with Harrisburg Area Community College in Lancaster. Each program provides the opportunity to jump-start college while in high school.

The demand for these programs is great and the Early College Academy (ECA) with HACC at Lancaster expands capacity so all eligible students can benefit from this academic pathway. If you think this may be a consideration for your child, here are a few ECA highlights.

Academic Highlights

- Students complete 60 college credits while in high school and receive an Associate's Degree at the same time as they
 graduate from high school.
- Students can complete their freshman and sophomore years of college while still in high school.
- Coursework is transferrable to colleges throughout Pennsylvania and many out-of-state institutions.
- Coursework in the general studies major is progressively more rigorous and designed to be academically appropriate for each grade level.

Co-curricular & Support Services

- High school and college advisors work with students throughout their enrollment in the ECA.
- Academic seminars are offered each year to prepare students for the academic rigor of the ECA.
