SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Spring Keystone Exams were presented. Students in Penn's Grove tested at or above the state level in Literature, Algebra and Biology.

ESY and Summer Academies were well attended by 632 students and PG and HS students recovered 191 credits.

New teachers were welcomed by the district with a two-day induction program beginning at Hopewell. This included a tour of Oxford Area School District and a Picnic at Oxford Memorial Park.

Returning teachers and staff will be welcomed back on Wednesday and Thursday.

Oxford Area High School students athletes, coaches, athletic director, and administrators were congratulated for receiving the distinction of earning the 2022-2023 PIAA District One Sportsmanship Award.

Oxford Area School District will welcome 170 new kindergarten students to Jordan Bank this year.

We are excited to announce the opening of the Hornet Virtual Academy. Students will work with nearly 100 teachers in 140 courses. There are 25 students currently enrolled.

District assessments begin on September 6 across all grades.

Nottingham and Hopewell will be hosting a Parent Engagement event at First Friday on October 6, 2023, 5-8 p.m. with a theme of Hometown Harvest.

The first Family Read will be held on October 11, 2023, 6-7:30 p.m. at Hopewell School and Oxford Reading Club will meet October 25, 2023, 6-7:30 p.m. at Jordan Bank School.
