Dr. Woods relinquished time to Dr. Margaret Billings-Jones who presented the report for the month of June. Dr. Billings-Jones shared graduation statistics. OAHS graduated two hundred sixtysix seniors on May 31, 2024. Of these graduates, twenty-five were Hornet Virtual Academy students, five were ROTC Cadets, seventy-seven were Technical College High School students, and eight were Early College Academy.

Oxford is gearing up for the summer extended learning program. There are four hundred seventy-two students enrolled. Summer programs include academies like STEM, coding, Young Authors, personal fitness. Credit recovery and advancement is also available. Ninety students enrolled in Hornet Virtual Academy this summer. Seventy -nine students are pursuing credit recovery and eleven of students are taking Algebra I in order to qualify for the Early College Academy in ninth grade this fall.

CHESTER COUNTY Mrs. Kehs reported the council met on May 22, 2024. They received SCHOOL BOARDS updates on the Legislative Committee will be in session. LEGISLATIVE SB 795 amends the award for Pennsylvania Award for Student Success. COUNCIL HB 1097 provides for a moment of silence on the anniversary of 9/11 and directs PDE to identify curriculum and instruction about the events of September 11, 2001. HB 851-adjusts available funding to provide menstrual hygiene products. HB 1367-provides mental health awareness for student athletes and coaches. HB 2007-online academic assessment. HB 2311-requiring mental health screening for all students. HB 1032-discusses solar energy at schools and grant money for the program. HB 2043-restricts student use of cell phones during the school day.

There were also discussions on cutting personal tax rates from 3.07 percent down to 2.8 percent and eliminating tax on electricity. Cyber tuition reform and a multi-year proposal which would change PA fair funding formula to close the gap between districts. Cyber Charter school funding reform was also discussed.

A special education rebate program was discussed, and the Junior ROTC program will be placed on hold for the next year.

Mr. Patterson reported that Michaela Walker was state champion in The 100-meter hurdles, she also has 2 indoor and 2 outdoor State Championships and is a five-time PIAA medalist. Michaela is the most accomplished athlete in the history of OASD.

Information on fall sports has been sent out for the High School and Penn's Grove School.

There is a new athletic director on the agenda for approval this evening.

An RFP for mats will go out soon.
